








NATASHA AGARWAL

Between 2016 and 2018 she crafted new dramaturgies and libretti for three award winning and award nominated opera adaptations for The King's Head Theatre, before founding her own company, The Opera Makers, in 2019 to support emerging artists. This year she created and directed a radical adaptation of Puccini's Turandot for Grimeborn opera festival - the first outside Asia to feature an entirely BESEA cast. Recent productions include 5 years with Spitalfields Music, for the Musical Rumpus Programme, The Bed for LAT (Offies 2020 finalist) and Paper Aeroplane for Half Moon Theatre (Offies 2021 finalist).


